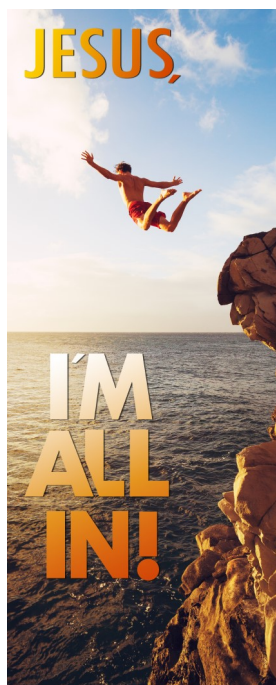


Mission Idaho Update

Stop by the back of the Main Auditorium to see what the students of several of our Adventist Christian elementary schools have accomplished over the past school year.



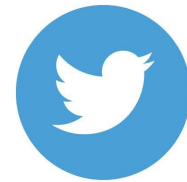
